Ethical Systems Check List

Your presentations should reflect your knowledge and understanding of your chosen Ethical System. Slides should NOT be "walls of text" that you merely read to the class but summarize, distill, and explain the Ethical System to the class.

You should have:

- Read what the text has to say.
- Researched on the Net for further and/or more in-depth information

Then, in your presentation....

- Defined (formal and in own words) the philosophy of the Ethical System
- Stated who the major influential philosophers are (NO biographies)
- Stated their theories AND how they differ from each other
- Listed the pros and cons of adhering to this Ethical System
- Provided real-world examples of the Ethical System in action to which we can relate.
- Cite your sources in MLA format on the last slide/page
- Write 5 MC test questions on your ethical system (not too specific based on trivia, and not to broad or obvious)
